Each year, Nashville's Civic Design Center invites designers to reimagine urban streetscape through its PARK(ing) Day competition. **In 2025, ESa was honored with the winning entry** for Sweet Relief, a vibrant and inviting parklet designed in collaboration with the Cupcake Collection in Germantown. What was once a single parking space is an extension of the bakery and a colorful space integrated into the heart of the neighborhood.

By day, it's a place where customers can enjoy a sweet treat under playful rainbow-colored shadows cast from acrylic panels above. By evening, it shifts into a public retreat, open for anyone to sit, gather and connect with the community.







